REFERENCE:

POLICY: Consistent with our values to protect and serve in a professional manner, it shall be the policy of the Cape Vincent Police Department to ensure the safety and well-being of all employees operating village-owned vehicles.

PURPOSE: To maintain a safe working environment and prevent workplace injuries to employees and others.

PROCEDURE:

- I. All Police Department personnel operating village-owned motor vehicles shall be required to wear the seatbelt/safety restraint system in a proper manner while operating said vehicle.
- II. All Police Department personnel occupying village-owned motor vehicles as passengers shall also be required to wear the seatbelt/safety restraint system in a proper manner while occupying said vehicle.
- III. It shall be the responsibility of the vehicle operator to ensure that all occupants of village-owned motor vehicles are restrained in compliance with New York State Vehicle and Traffic Laws.
