Article 1. - Statement of Authority. The Board of Trustee's in the Village of Cape Vincent pursuant to the authority granted it under Article 4 of the Village Law, the Vehicle and Traffic Law State of New York Sections 10 and 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law hereby enacts as follows:

Article 2. - Statement of Purpose and Findings. The Board of Trustees of the Village of Cape Vincent finds that parking in the first block of James Street off Broadway has caused congestion making it difficult for the motoring public to use James Street and has caused other people to park across sidewalks. It is the purpose of this local law to establish diagonal parking in James Street between Broadway and Kelsey Lane with a two (2) hour limit between the hours of 7:00a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Article 3. - Enactment. The Board of Trustees of the Village of Cape Vincent hereby establishes the following:

A. Diagonal parking on the both sides of James Street commencing twenty (20) feet from Broadway to Kelsey Lane with a two (2) hour limit between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00p.m.

B. Any person in violation of this local law shall be guilty of a violation which will be punishable by a fine of not less than fifteen dollars (\$15.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each such violation.

Article 4. - Severability. If any part of this Chapter shall be found to be void, voidable, or unenforceable for any reason whatsoever, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any remaining section or provision of this Chapter.

Article 5. - Effective Date. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
